Methodology

- Poll conducted among 1023 adults 18 years-of-age and older, drawn from a proportionate random sample from across Canada from October 12th to October 16th, 2006.
- Margin of error +/- 3.1% 19 times out of 20.
- Regional target quotas and margins of error.

Key Findings

- Three out of five Canadians (57%) feel that the increase in American investments in Canada is a bad idea, while 31% say it would be good news for Canada.
- Regionally, the smaller provinces in Manitoba / Saskatchewan (38%) and the Atlantic (39%) are the most likely to say that the increase in American investment it is good news for Canada.
- Men (38%) are much more likely then women (25%) to say increased American investment is good news.
- English speaking Canadians (34%) feel stronger then French speaking (23%) that an increase in American investments is good news for Canada.
- There were no significant differences between age groups or urban vs.
 rural residents on whether the investment is good news or bad news.
