Methodology

- This survey was conducted by telephone among 606 randomly-selected Ontario residents, 18 years of age or older from Friday, May 15th to Tuesday, May 19th, 2015. This study was conducted by telephone, calling landlines and cell phones. Calling cell phones ensures adequate representation of the younger age cohort who are increasingly less likely to have a landline telephone. Overall, 39% of respondents were contacted on cell phones in this sample.
- Only one respondent per household was eligible to complete this survey.
- The sample has been weighted by age, gender and region using the latest available data from Statistics Canada Census to reflect the actual demographic composition of the population.
- After weighting a sample of this size, the aggregated results are considered accurate to within ±4.0%, 19 times out of 20.
- The margin of error will be larger within each sub-grouping of the sample.




Ontario PCs and Liberals in statistical tie; 1-in-6 undecided

... In that case, which party's candidate do you lean toward slightly? [Vote + Lean]







... In that case, which party's candidate do you lean toward slightly? [DECIDED VOTE] [n=434]










Patrick Brown largely unknown; Wynne seen as *least* favourable and Horwath as *most* favourable



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

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





Kathleen Wynne viewed most favourable by young women, GTA, university educated






