Hill Times Questions

Methodology

- The online survey was conducted among current members of the INNOVATIVE's Canada 20/20 panel between May 31 and June 4, 2007.
- The total study included 1,067 responses eligible for inclusion in our analysis. After weighting a sample of this size the aggregated results are considered accurate to within 3.0 percentage points, 19 times out of 20, of what they would have been had a representative cross-section of Canadians eligible to vote been polled.
- The margin of error will be larger within each sub-grouping of the sample





Compared to past federal governments do you think that the current Conservative government is . . . ?






Majority feel media bias depends on the outlet



Overall, when reporting the news, do you feel that there is a consistent bias by the Canadian media in favour of . . .






Two-thirds only believe some of what they see in the media

How much do you trust of what you read, see or hear in the Canadian media? Do you trust ...?












Dispute with press leaves strong net negative impression towards Prime Minister Harper






Two-thirds feel Prime Minister is to blame for dispute with Press Gallery

Thinking about this dispute, who do you think is more to blame?






Strong support for media's case with the PMO's secrecy




Do you agree or disagree with each of the following statements?



Majority say dispute makes them question Harper's commitment to openness




Do you agree or disagree with each of the following statement: The Prime Ministers fight with the national media leaves me questioning whether he is really committed to openness in government
