# Methodology

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- The online survey was conducted among current members of the INNOVATIVE's Canada 20/20 panel between May 31 and June 4, 2007.
- The total study included 1,067 responses eligible for inclusion in our analysis. After weighting a sample of this size the aggregated results are considered accurate to within 3.0 percentage points, 19 times out of 20, of what they would have been had a representative cross-section of Canadians eligible to vote been polled.
- The margin of error will be larger within each sub-grouping of the sample

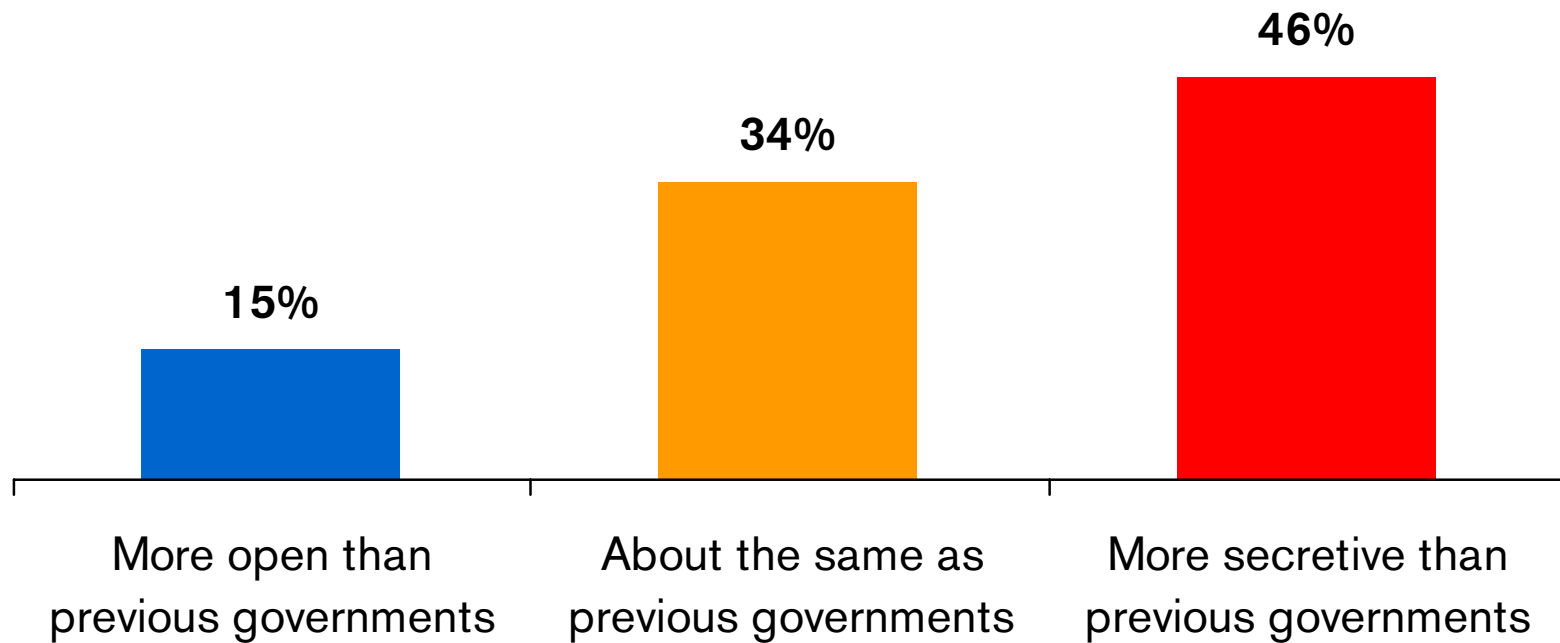
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# Almost half feel federal government is more secretive than previous governments

Compared to past federal governments do you think that the current Conservative government is . . . ?



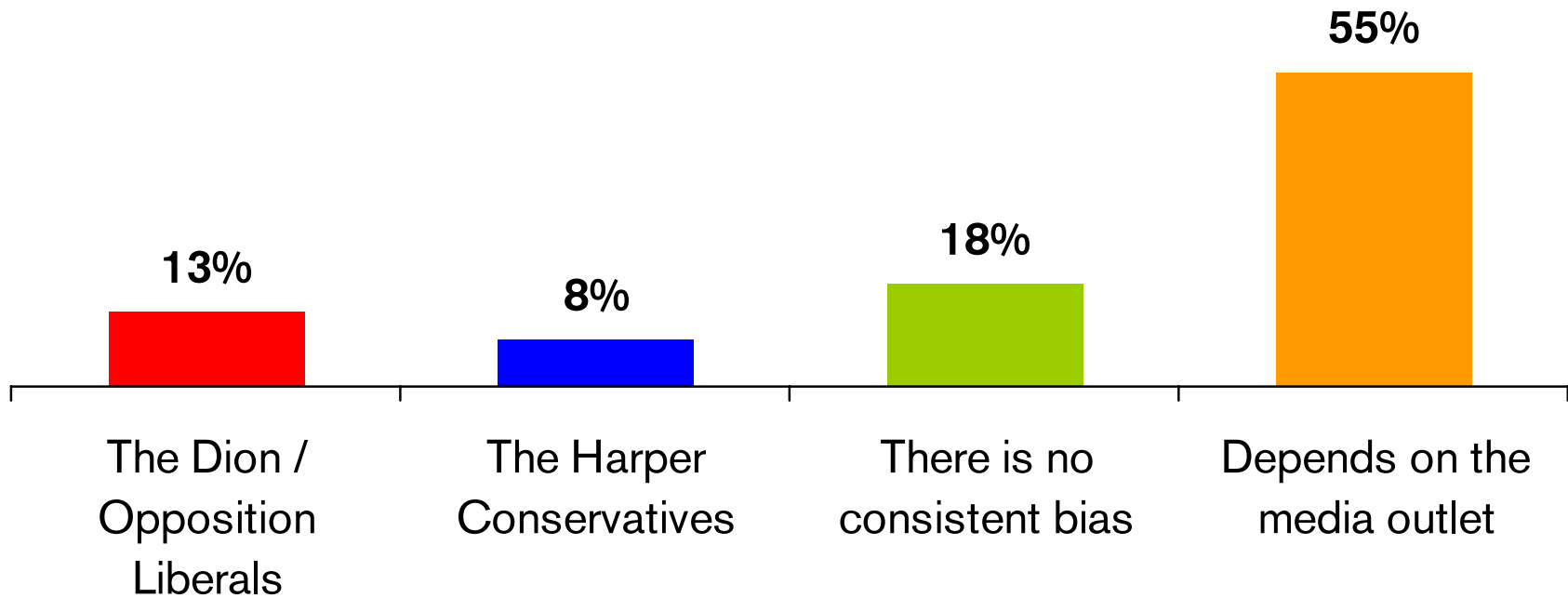

Overall, when reporting the news, do you feel that there is a consistent bias by the Canadian media in favour of . . .



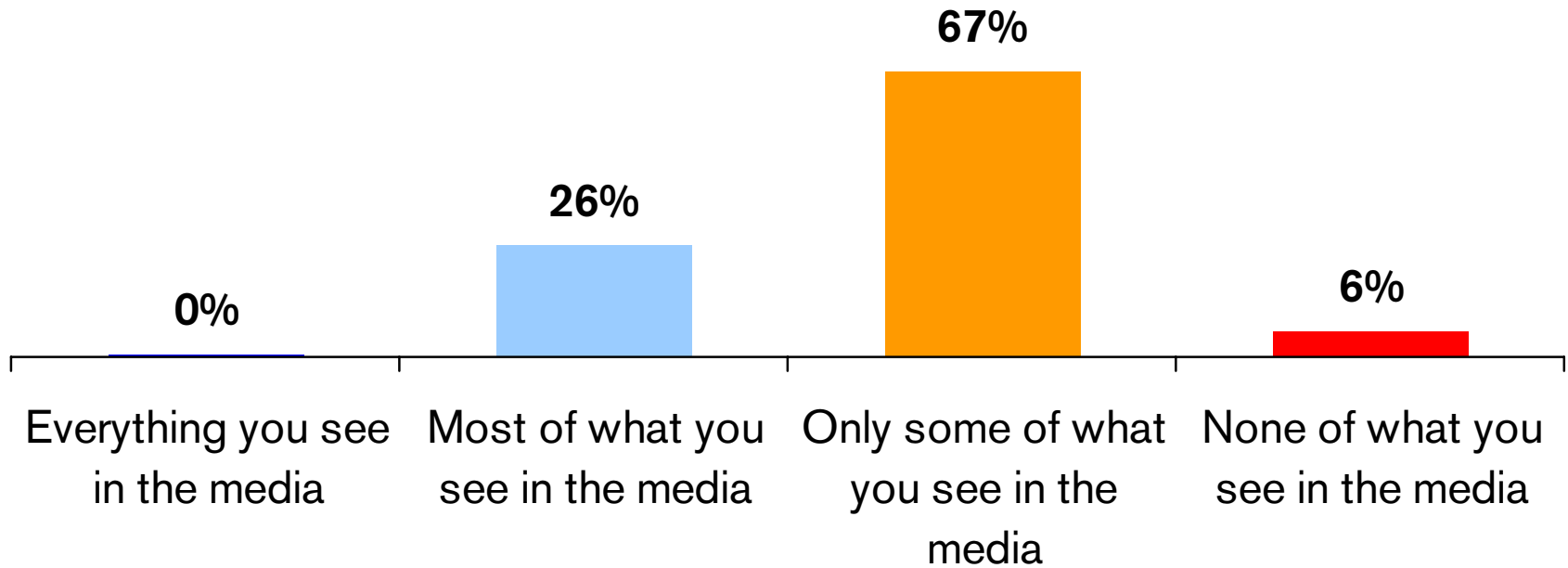

How much do you trust of what you read, see or hear in the Canadian media? Do you trust ...?



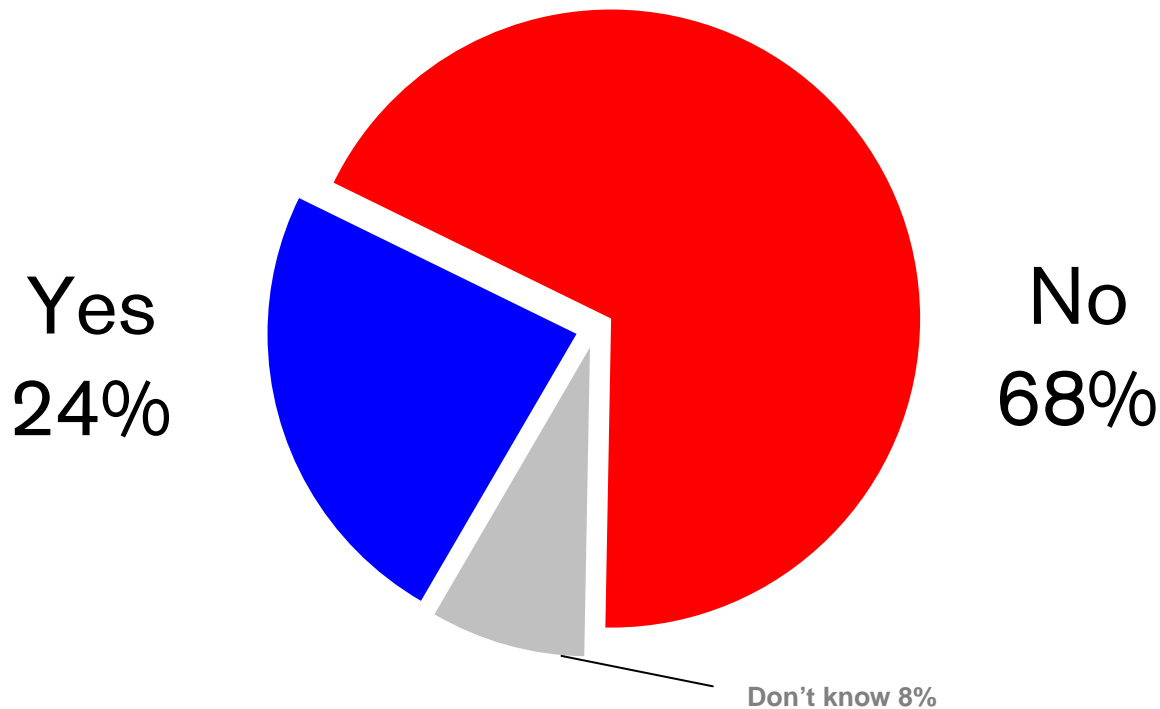

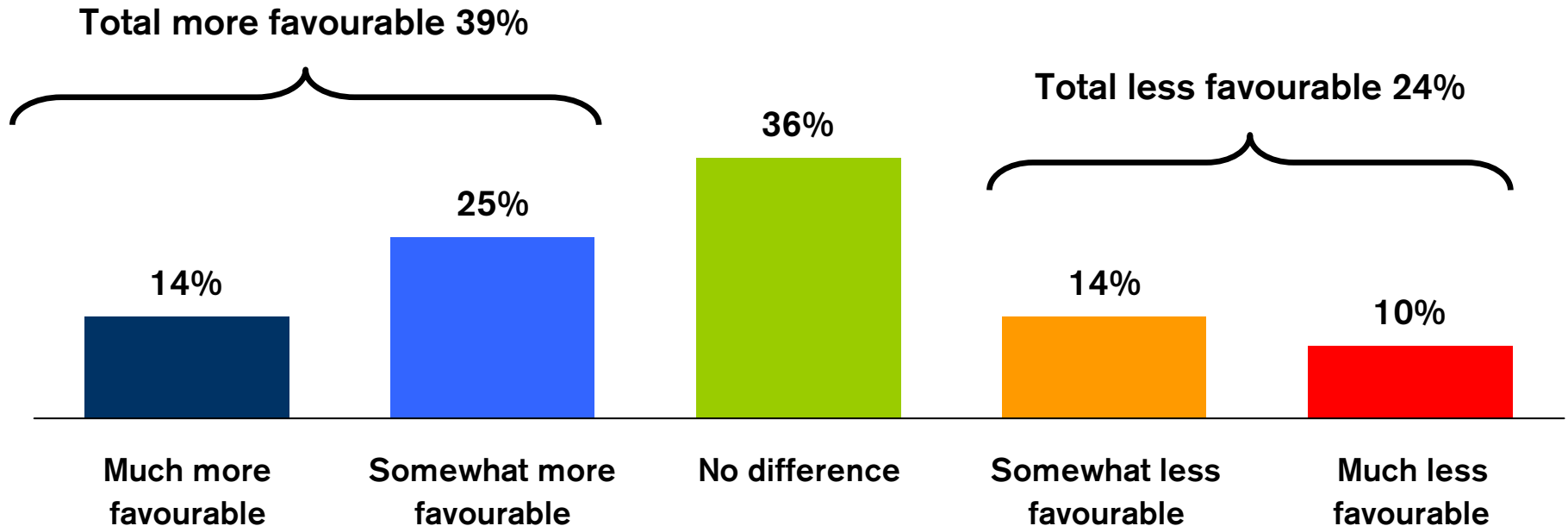

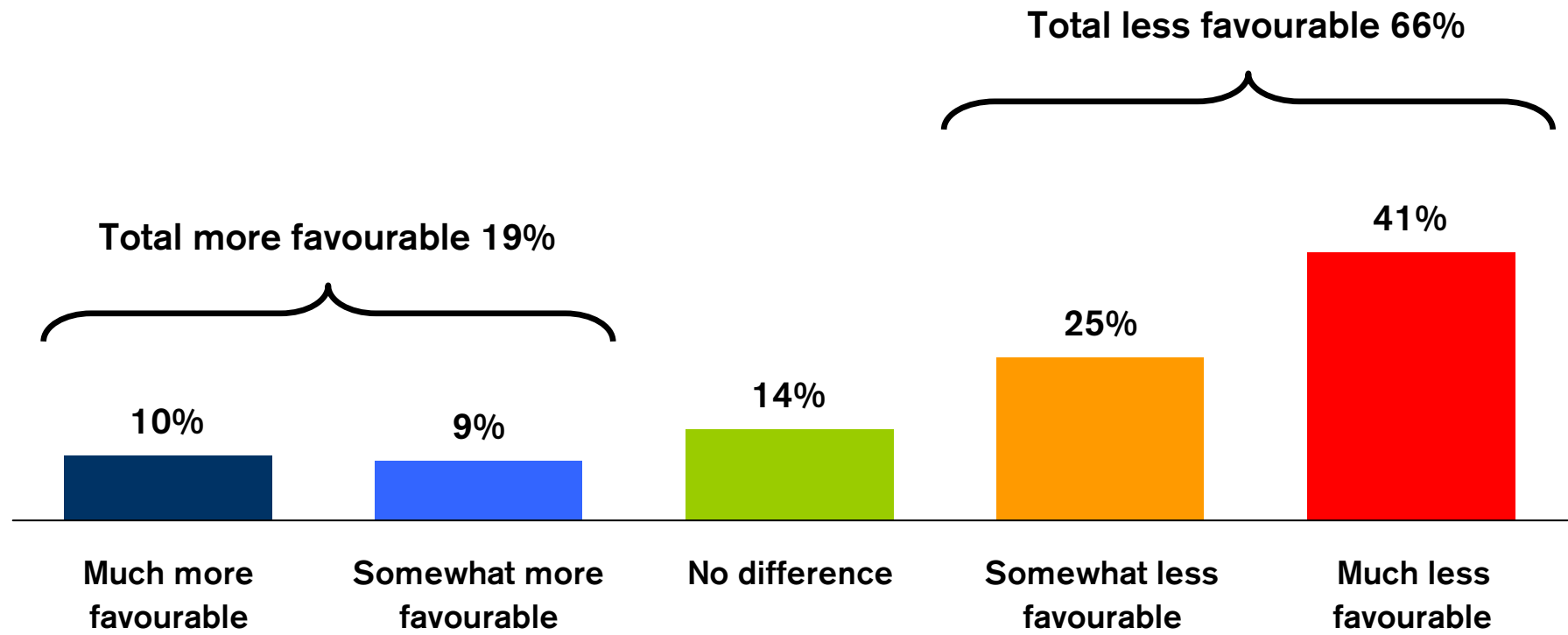

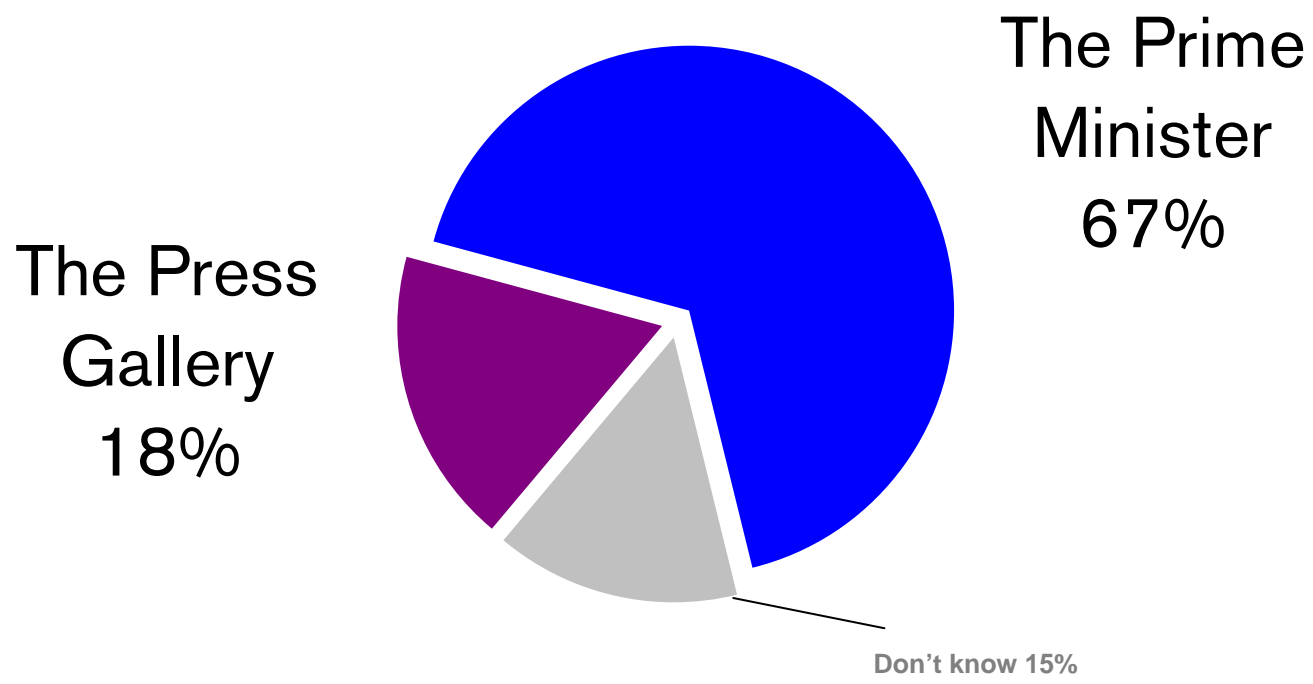

# Two-thirds feel Prime Minister is to blame for dispute with Press Gallery

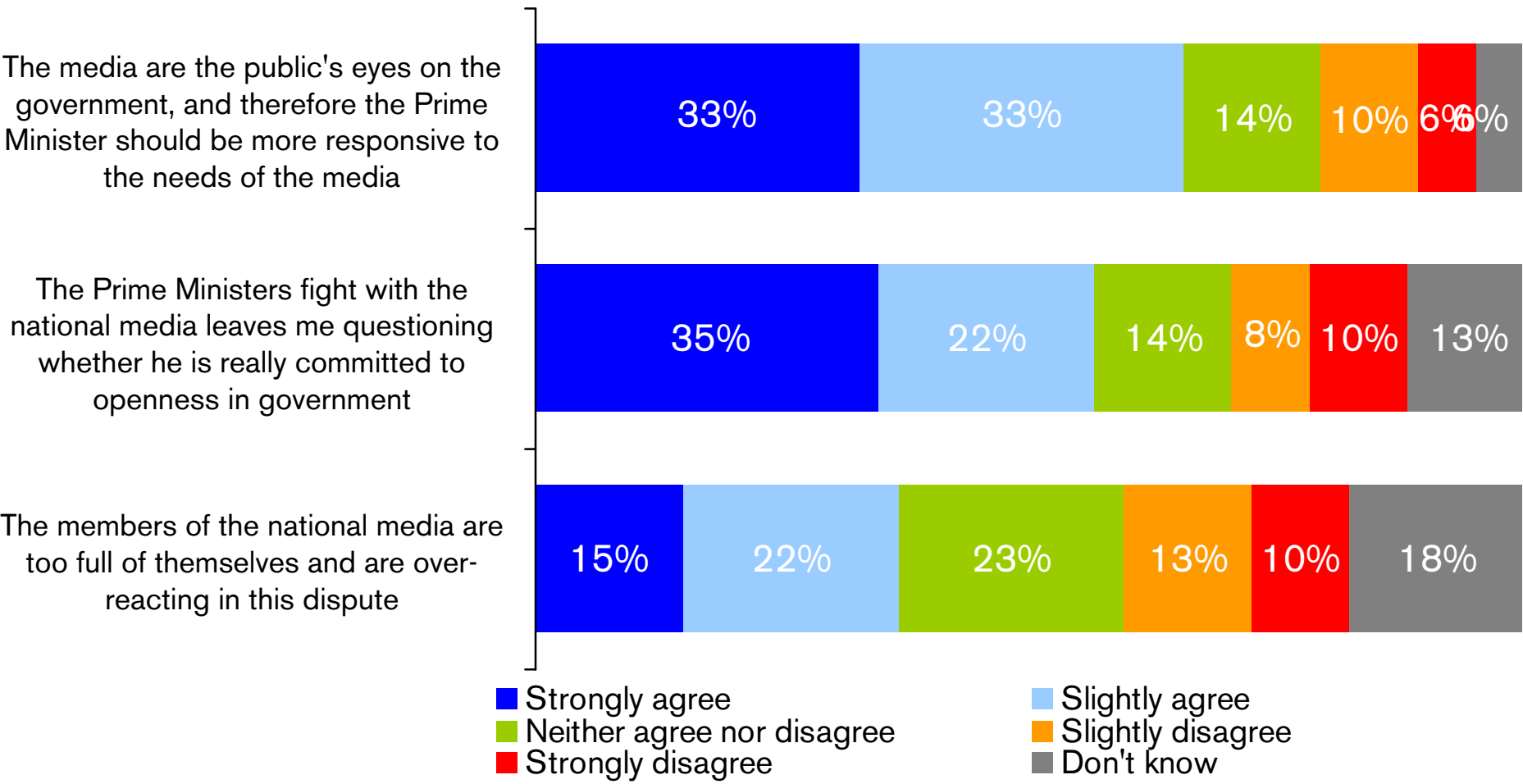
Q Thinking about this dispute, who do you think is more to blame . . . .?

# Strong support for media's case with the PMO's secrecy 13

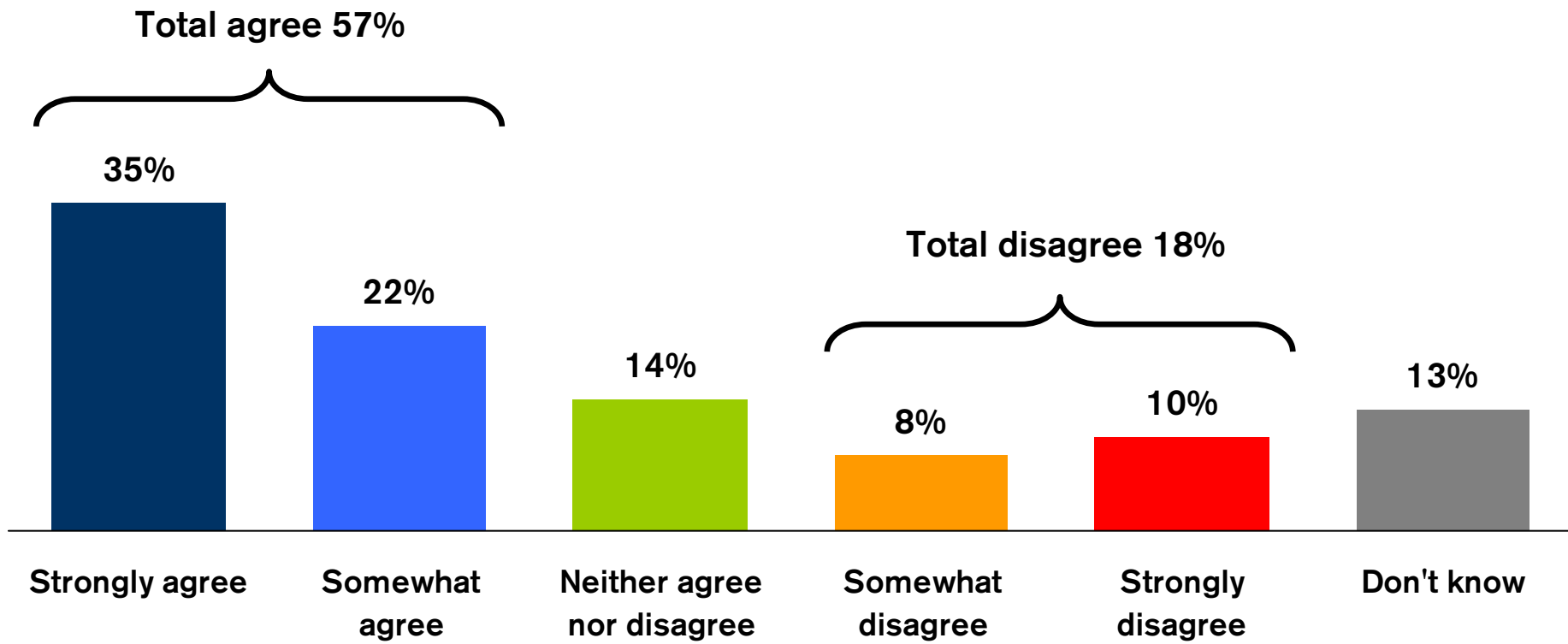
**Q** Do you agree or disagree with each of the following statements?

Do you agree or disagree with each of the following statement: **The Prime Ministers fight with the national media leaves me questioning whether he is really committed to openness in government**

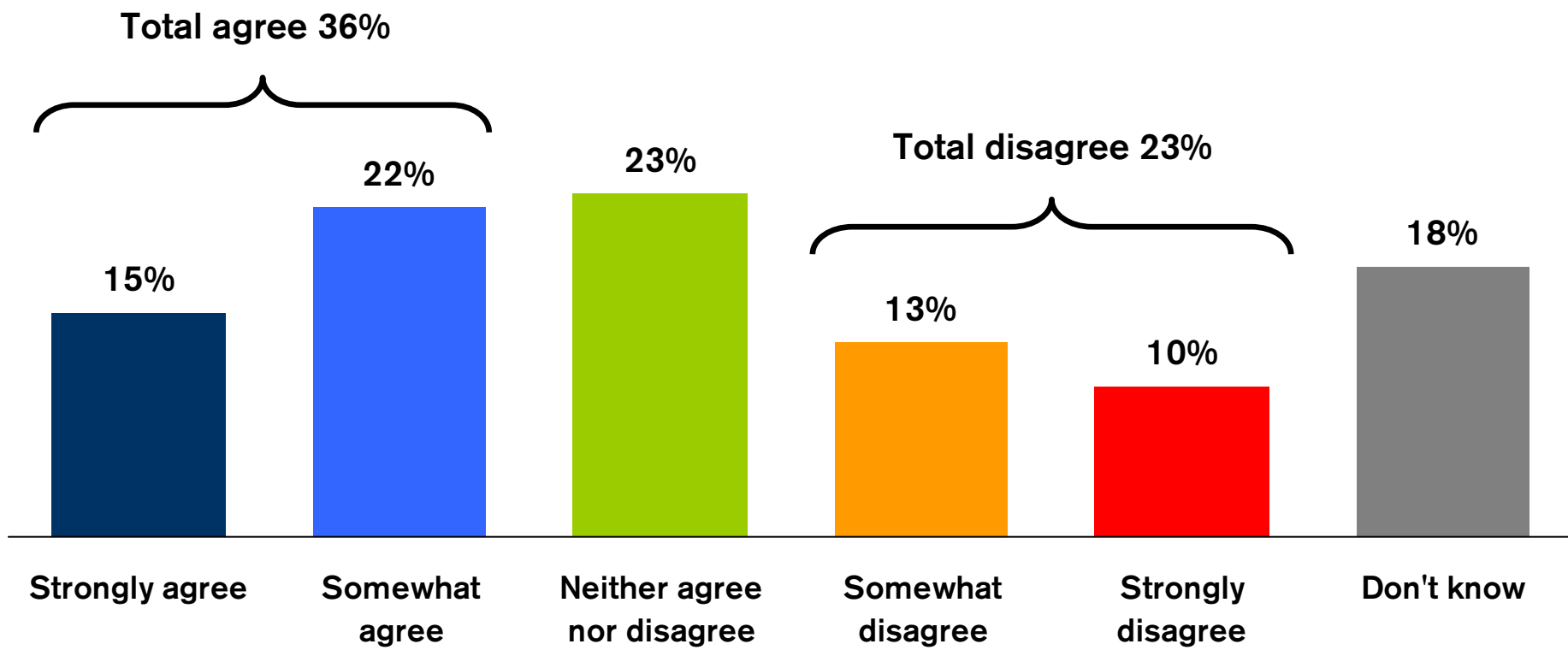

Do you agree or disagree with each of the following statement: **The members of the national media are too full of themselves and are over-reacting in this dispute**

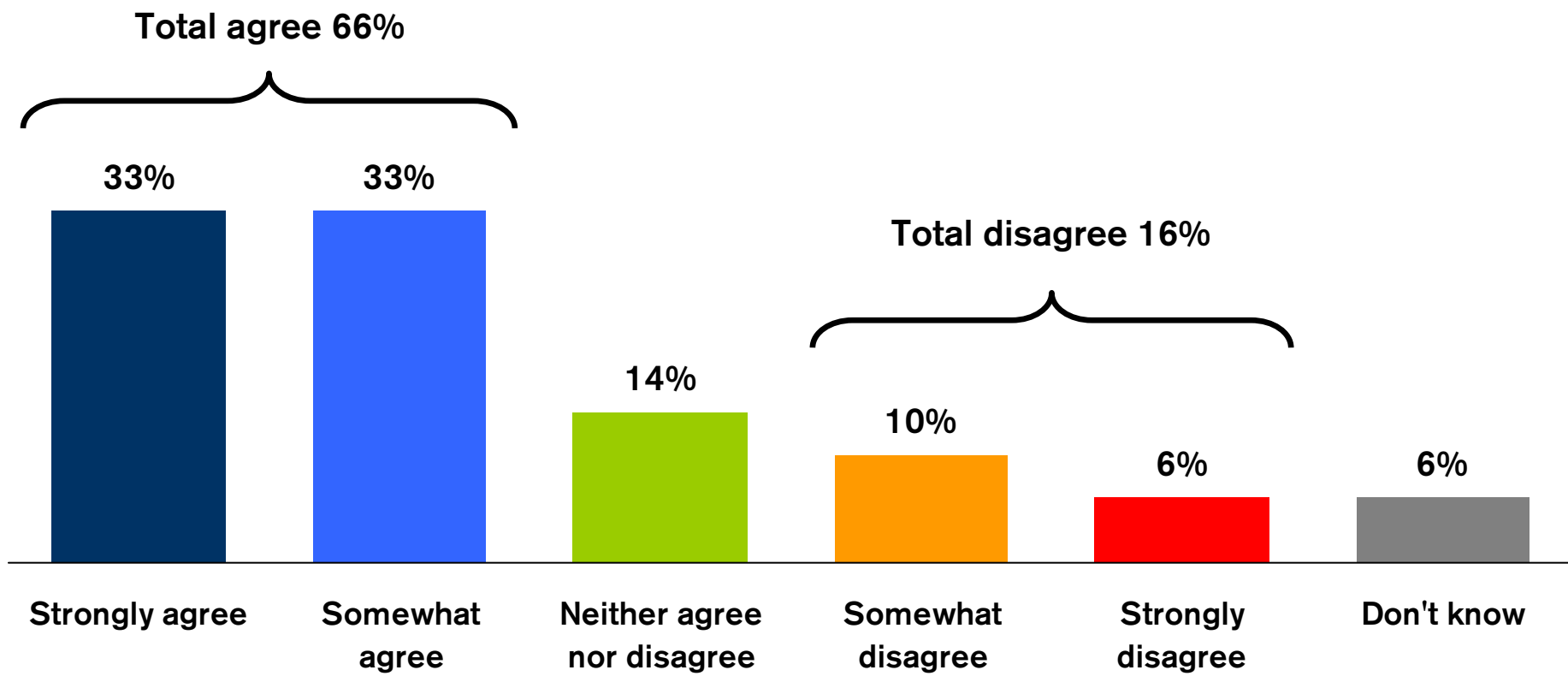
