Today, INNOVATIVE is releasing results from our January 2021 *Canada This Month* survey. This online survey was in field from January 7th to February 1st, 2021 with a weighted sample size of 2,000. Detailed methodology is provided in the appendix.


This report covers how Canadians' values have changed since the start of 2020 and how different value groups have changed over time. We find that while most values have remained largely stable over time, there has been a decline in populism and a rise in willingness to spend since the COVID-19 pandemic began.

Federal Vote Tracking




If a federal election were held today, which party would you vote for? In that case, which party do you lean toward slightly? [Vote + Lean] [asked of all respondents; n=2000]





■ The public's need for the programs and services











If a federal election were held today, which party would you vote for? In that case, which party do you lean toward slightly? [Vote + Lean] [showing Core Left]






Thrifty Moderates Vote

If a federal election were held today, which party would you vote for? In that case, which party do you lean toward slightly? [Vote + Lean] [showing Thrifty Moderates]








Populist Conservatives Vote

If a federal election were held today, which party would you vote for? In that case, which party do you lean toward slightly? [Vote + Lean] [showing Populist Conservatives]








Deferential Conservatives Vote

If a federal election were held today, which party would you vote for? In that case, which party do you lean toward slightly? [Vote + Lean] [showing Deferential Conservatives]






Business Liberals Vote

If a federal election were held today, which party would you vote for? In that case, which party do you lean toward slightly? [Vote + Lean] [showing Business Liberals]






Left Liberals Vote

If a federal election were held today, which party would you vote for? In that case, which party do you lean toward slightly? [Vote + Lean] [showing Left Liberals]







Do you agree or disagree with the following statements? - No matter how hard I work, every year it seems more difficult to get by




Economic Gap Segmentation








Achievers Vote



If a federal election were held today, which party would you vote for? In that case, which party do you lean toward slightly? [Vote + Lean] [showing Achievers]









If a federal election were held today, which party would you vote for? In that case, which party do you lean toward slightly? [Vote + Lean]





Methodology

Survey Methodology

These are the results of an online survey conducted between January 7th and February 1st, 2021.

Method: This online survey was conducted using INNOVATIVE's Canada 20/20 national research panel with additional respondents from Dynata, a leading provider of online sample. Each survey is administered to a series of randomly selected samples from the panel and weighted to ensure that the overall sample's composition reflects that of the actual Canadian population according to Census data to provide results that are intended to approximate a probability sample.

Sample Size: n=4,449 Canadian citizens, 18 years or older. The results are nationally weighted to n=2,000 based on Census data from Statistics Canada.

Field Dates: January 7th to February 1st, 2021

Weighting: Results for Canada are weighted by age, gender, and region to ensure that the overall sample's composition reflects that of the actual population according to Census data; in order to provide results that are intended to approximate a probability sample. Weighted and unweighted frequencies are reported in the table.

Margin of Error: This is a representative sample. However, since the online survey was not a random probability based sample, a margin of error cannot be calculated. Statements about margins of sampling error or population estimates do not apply to most online panels.

Note: Graphs may not always total 100% due to rounding values rather than any error in data. Sums are added before rounding numbers.
