About This Study

How often will voters forgive politicians for a big mistake?

Doug Ford is putting that question to the test.

In April 2021, Doug Ford apologized for the government's performance on COVID and went on to win re-election. INNOVATIVE tracked reaction to the controversy and the apology at the time. We have used updated versions of those questions to test reaction to the Premier's apology on the government's latest controversy – the Greenbelt.

INNOVATIVE runs a continuous tracking survey with a new sample every week. The Greenbelt Controversy questions were asked in the last three weeks of October while the final slide on decided vote are the results for the whole month of October.

Key Findings

- 1 Fewer have been following the Greenbelt Controversy compared to the COVID-19 Lockdown.**

While 3-in-4 (73%) have been following Ford's press conferences on the government's plan to combat COVID-19, just under 3-in-5 (57%) have been following the recent Greenbelt controversy, including the decision of the RCMP to open a criminal investigation.
- 2 More believe that Ford responded poorly to criticisms on the Greenbelt than to COVID-19.**

With a net well score of -19%, more disagree that Ford responded well to criticisms on the Greenbelt controversy compared to the government's response to COVID-19, which had a net well score of -9%. In both situations, NDP partisans were most likely to believe that Ford responded poorly to criticisms.
- 3 A little over half agreed both that the Greenbelt and COVID controversies are signs of deeper issues.**

Over half of respondents believe that the government's handling of the Greenbelt issue and the managing of measures to combat COVID-19 are signs of deeper issues with how the government is managing the province/pandemic. Among Liberal and PC partisans, more believe that the handling of the Greenbelt controversy is a sign of deeper issues compared to the management of COVID-19 measures.
- 4 Ontarians are divided over whether Premier Ford accepts responsibility and is trying to do better.**

Both on COVID (+6%) and the Greenbelt (+2%), slightly more Ontarians agreed than disagreed that *"Doug Ford has accepted responsibility for his mistakes and is taking steps to do better."*

Greenbelt Controversy

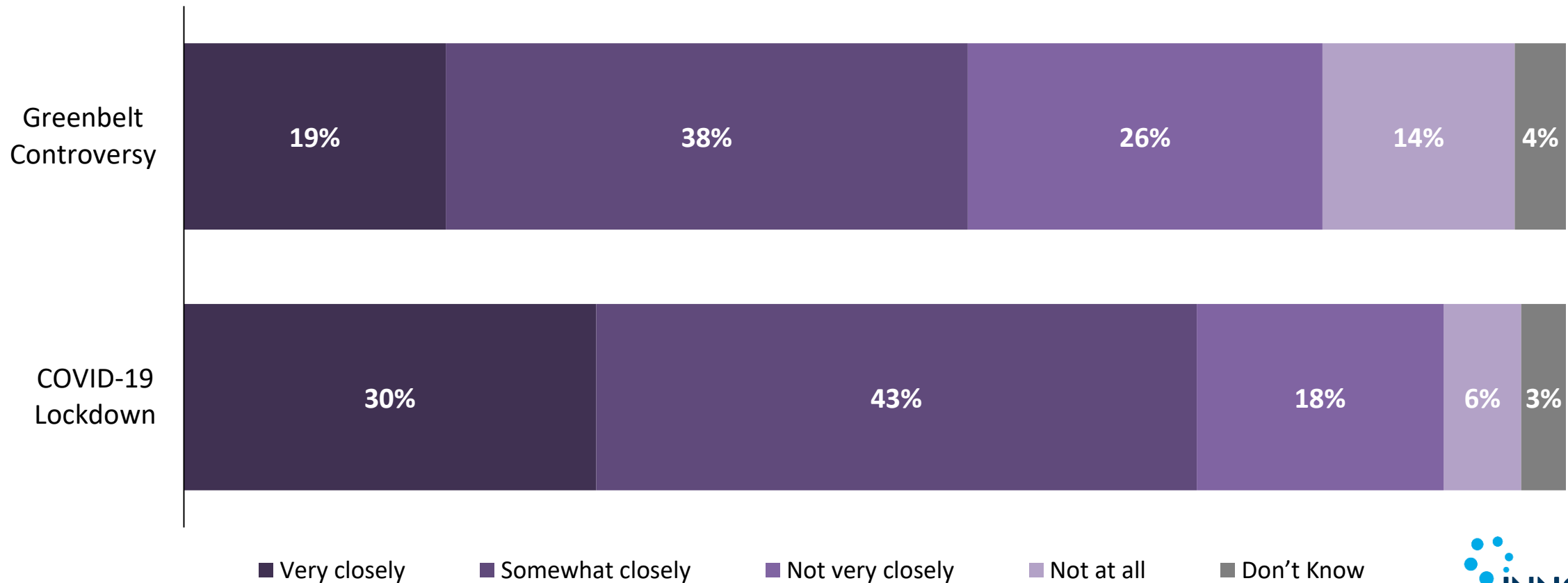
Awareness: While 3-in-4 (73%) followed the COVID-19 controversy closely, just under 3-in-5 (57%) are following the Greenbelt response.

Awareness BY Party ID: While the COVID-19 response was followed closest by NDP, the Greenbelt controversy is most followed by Liberals

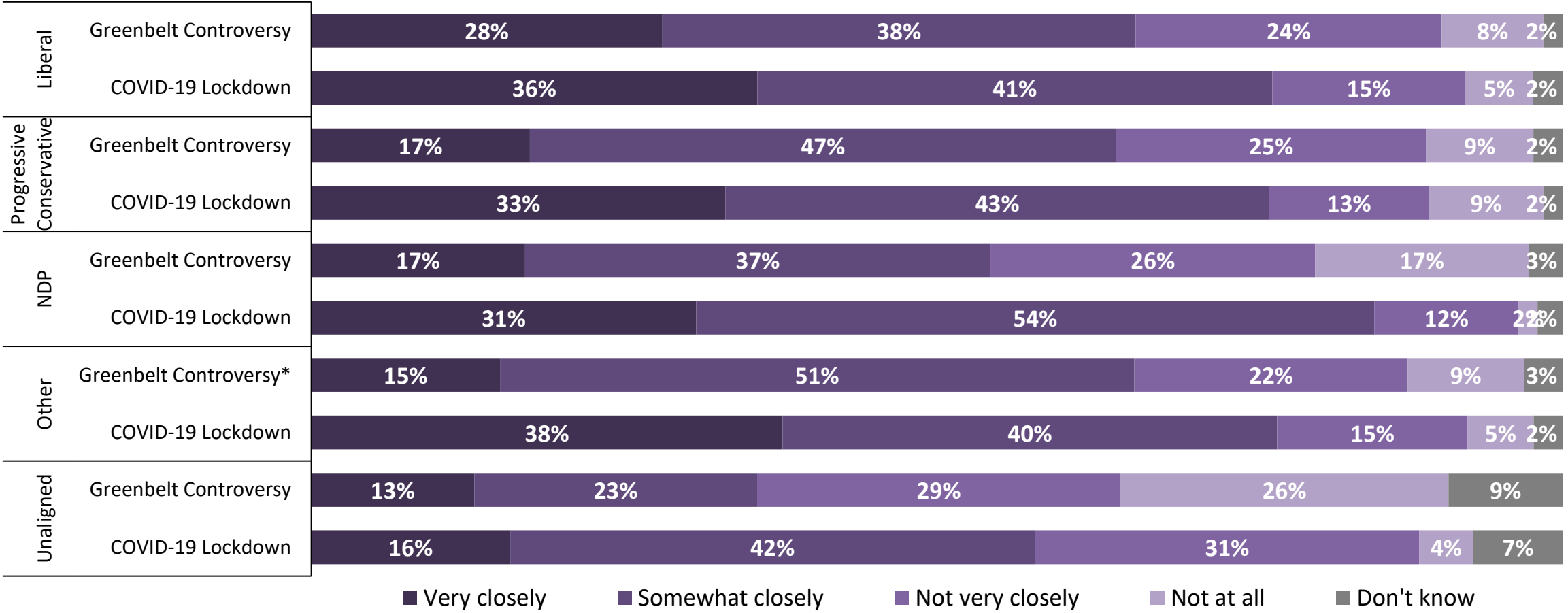

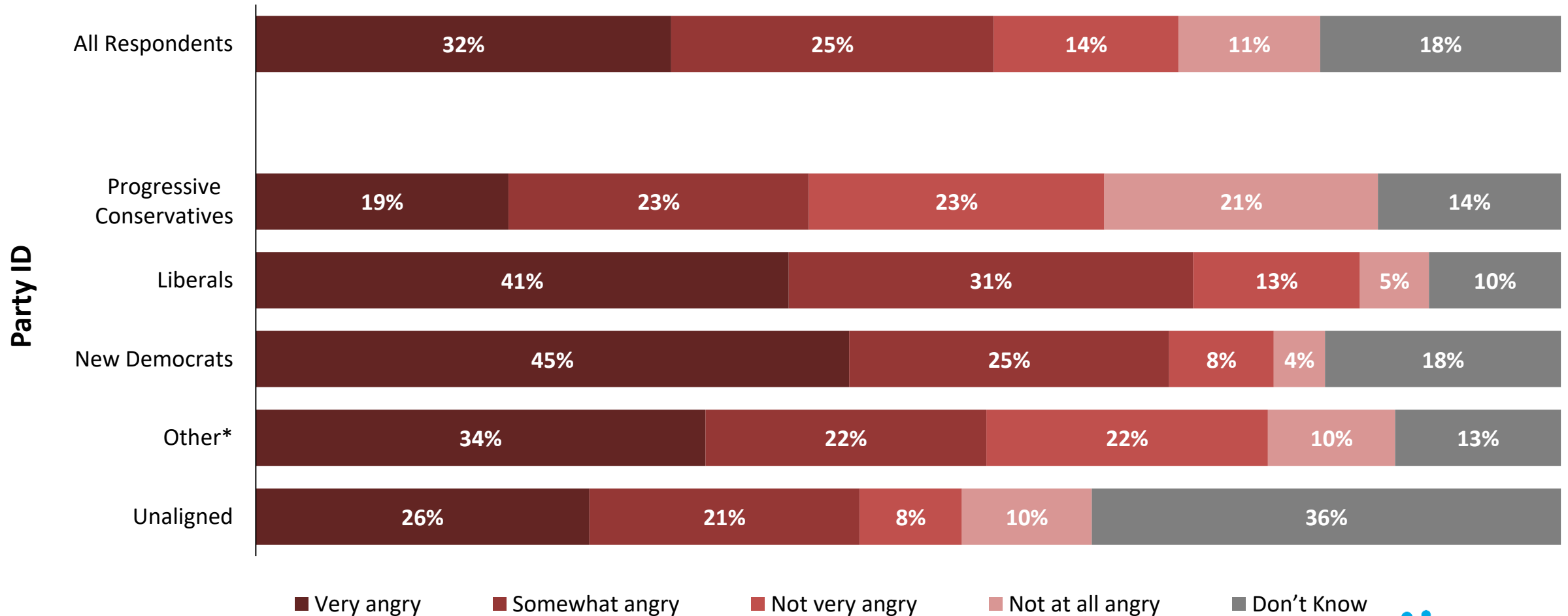

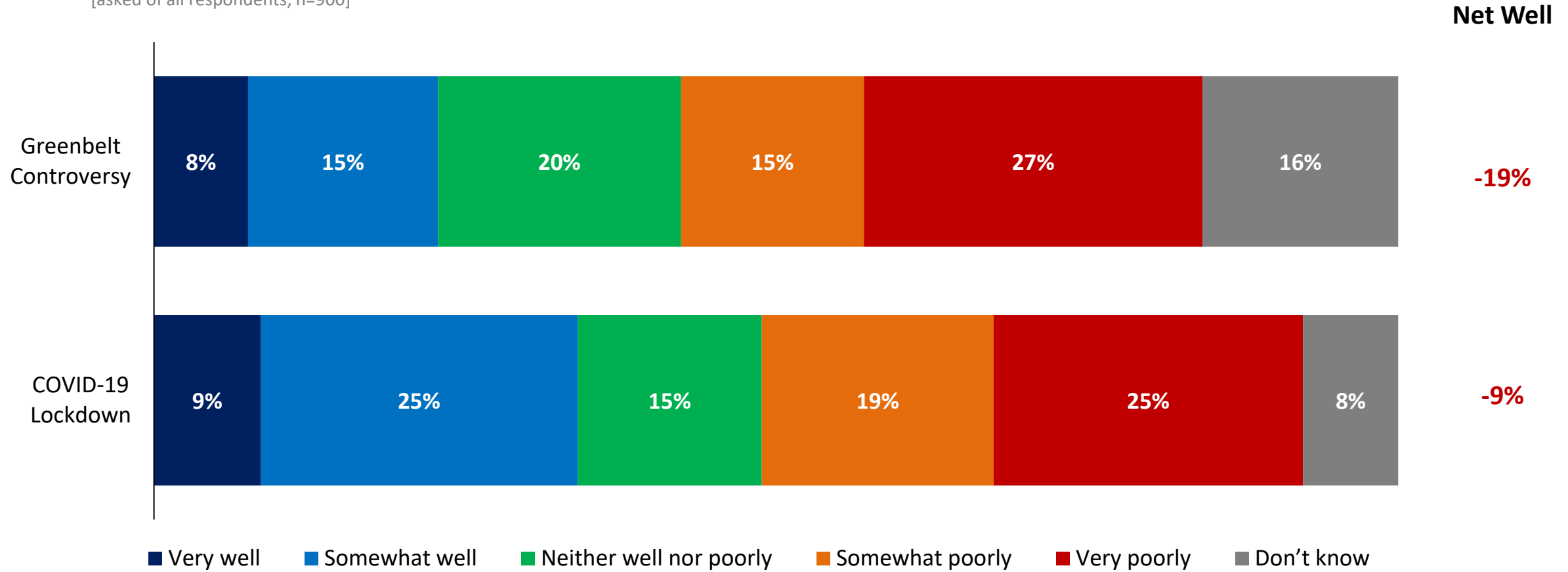
Ford's Response: Negative reactions on Greenbelt are similar to COVID, but positive reactions are much lower

Ford's Response BY Party ID: NDP partisans are most likely to believe that Ford responded poorly to criticisms on the Greenbelt (58%)



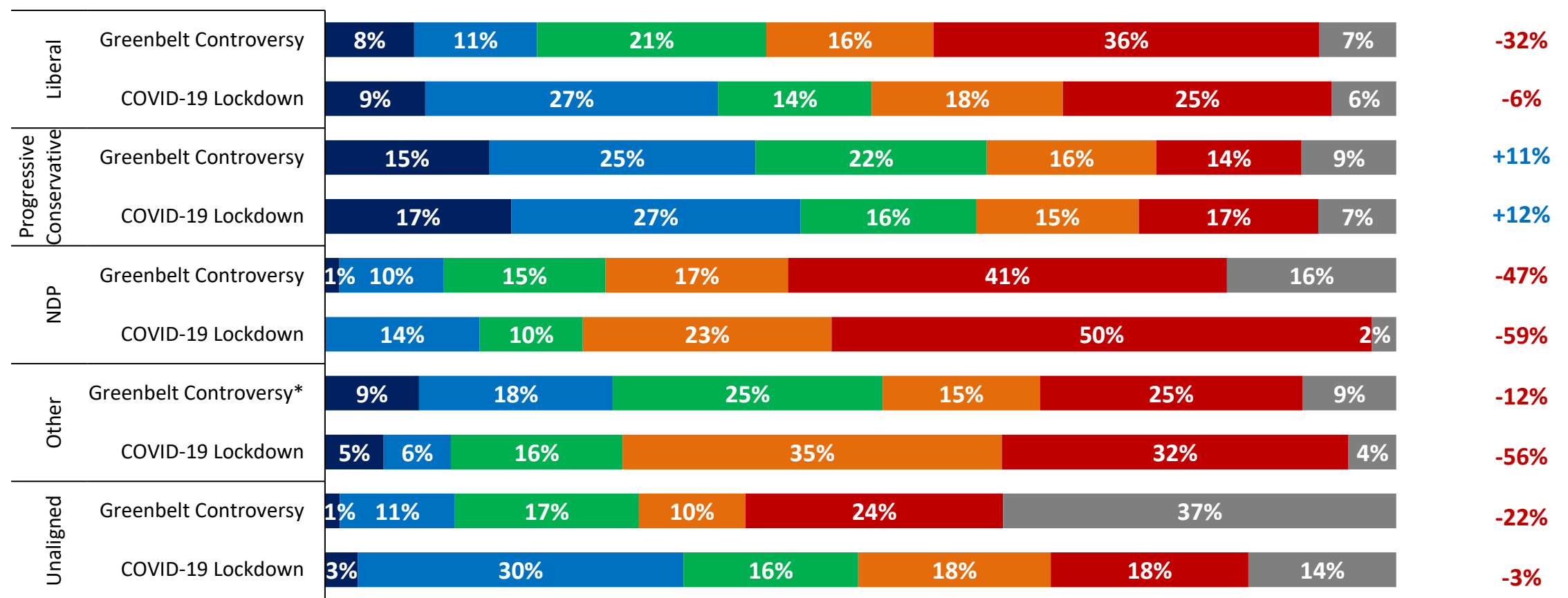

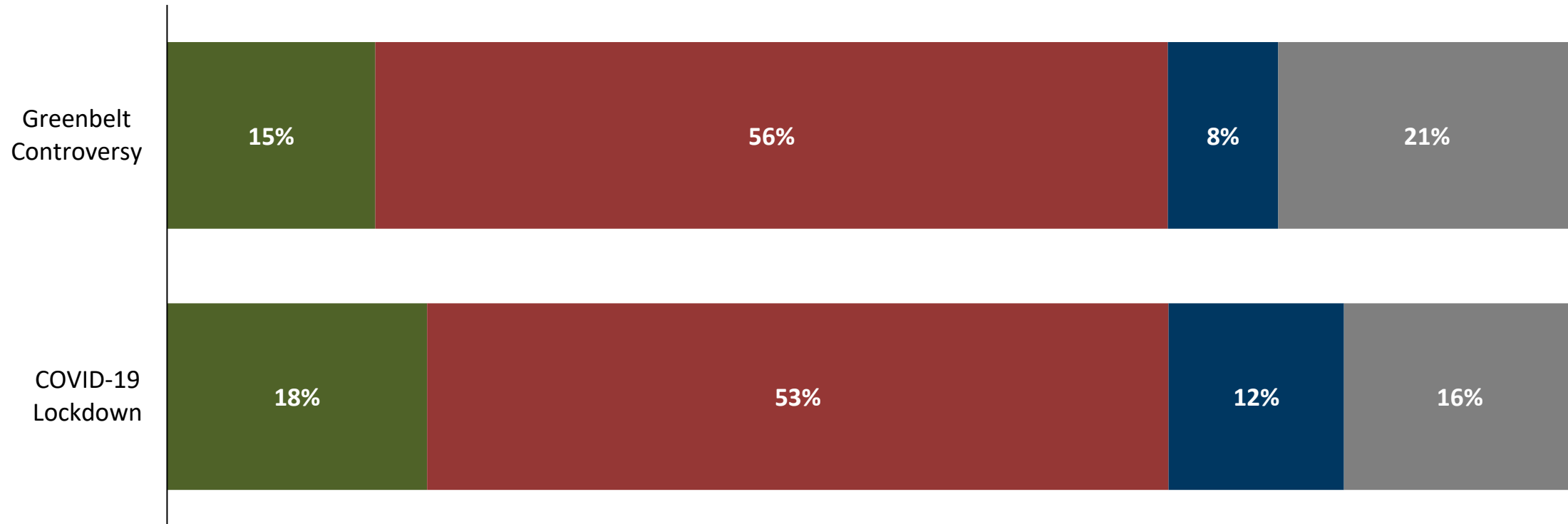
A Deeper Problem?: Just over half felt COVID and the Greenbelt controversies are signs of deeper issues with the government

A Deeper Problem? BY Party ID: More Liberal and PC partisans say the Greenbelt controversy is a sign of a deeper issue compared to COVID-19

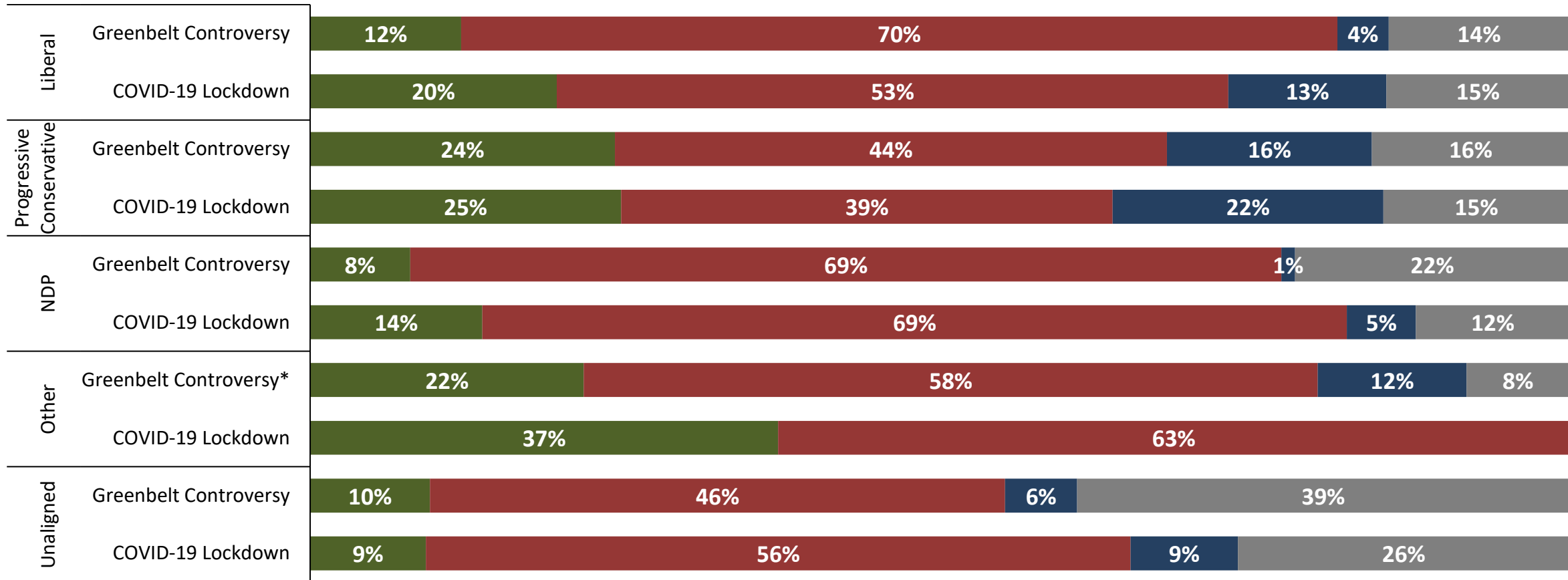

Key Attitude: Slightly more believed Ford accepted responsibility for his mistakes in COVID than the Greenbelt, but the numbers are close¹²

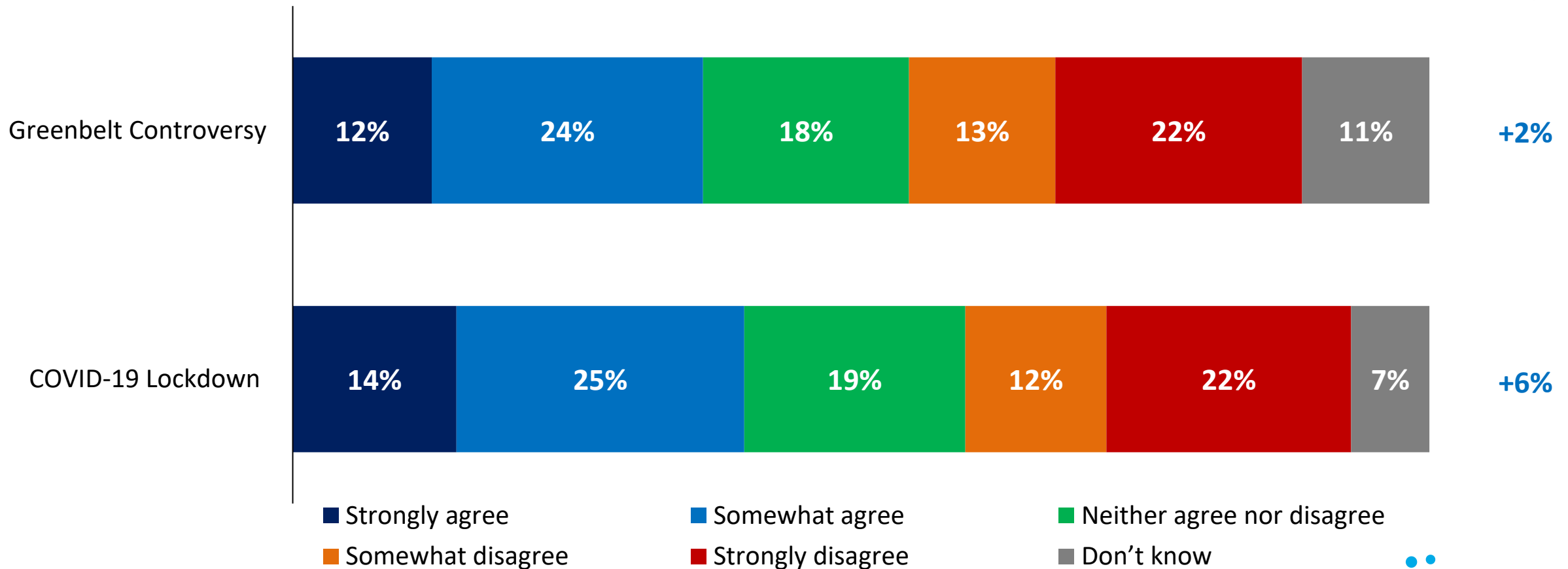

Ford's Response BY Party ID: Conservative partisans more forgiving on Greenbelt than they were on COVID



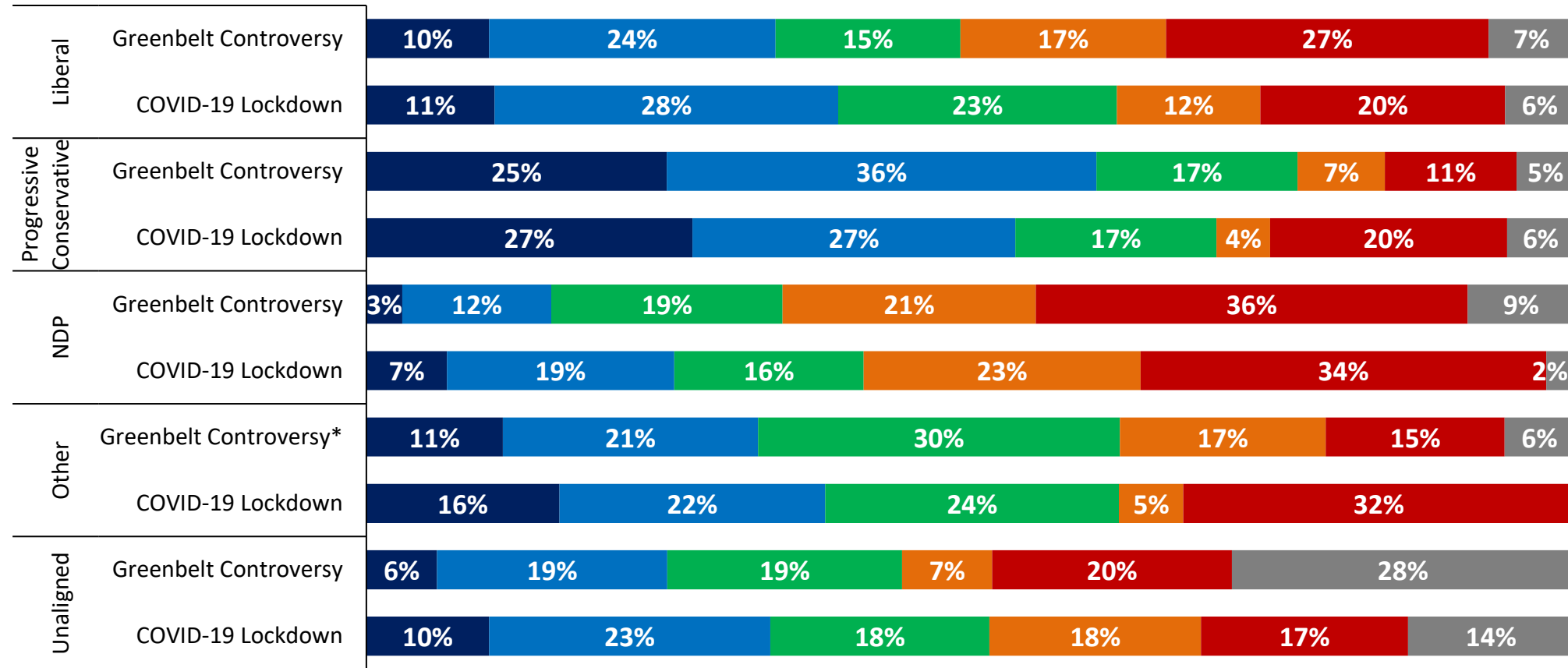

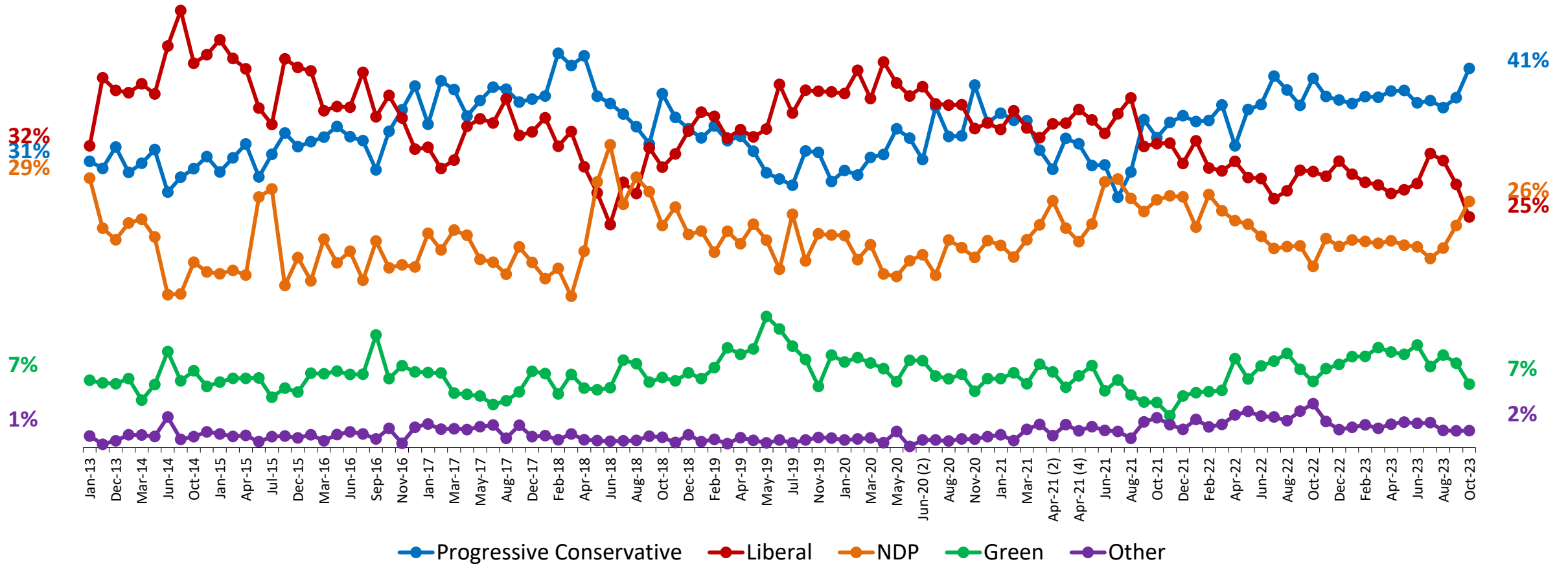
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Provincial Decided Vote Tracking: Despite the Greenbelt Controversy, Progressive Conservatives remain in the lead

Methodology

Survey Methodology



These are the results of an online survey conducted between October 12th and October 30th, 2023.

Method: This online survey was conducted using INNOVATIVE's Canada 20/20 national research panel with additional respondents from Lucid, a leading provider of online samples. Each survey is administered to a series of randomly selected samples from the panel and weighted to ensure that the overall sample's composition reflects that of the actual Ontario population according to Census data to provide results that are intended to approximate a probability sample.

Sample Size: n=1,360 Ontario residents, 18 years or older. The results are weighted to n=900 based on Census data from Statistics Canada.

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Weighting: Results for Canada are weighted by age, gender, region, and self-reported past federal vote to ensure that the overall sample's composition reflects that of the actual population according to Census data; in order to provide results that are intended to approximate a probability sample. Weighted and unweighted frequencies are reported in the table.

Margin of Error: This is a representative sample. However, since the online survey was not a random probability-based sample, a margin of error cannot be calculated. Statements about margins of sampling error or population estimates do not apply to most online panels.

Note: Graphs may not always total 100% due to rounding values rather than any error in data. Sums are added before rounding numbers. The decided vote tracking numbers are based on results for the whole month of October while results for the Greenbelt Controversy are of the last three weeks.
