

Key NDP Seats

Westside Lower Mainland

Until 2017, the BC Liberals normally won all of Richmond and the North Shore and half the West side of Vancouver. If NDP continue to win big in this region, it is hard for the Conservatives to catch up.

- North Vancouver-Seymour
- Vancouver-Langara
- Richmond-Steveston

South of the Fraser

Again, before 2017, the BC Liberals could count on all the ridings from South Delta through Cloverdale, Langley, Abbotsford and Chilliwack. If the NDP continue to win many of these seats, they likely are back in government.

- Surrey-Cloverdale
- Langley-Walnut Grove
- Abbotsford-Mission

Interior

The Interior is the BC Conservative bastion, but these seats are traditional swings and two have lost popular BC Liberal MLAs.

- Skeena

Key Conservative Seats

Eastern Lower Mainland

The NDP dominate eastern suburbs like Burnaby, the Tri-Cities and Maple Ridge. The BC Conservatives need to break through to make it into government.

- Coquitlam-Burke Mountain
- Maple Ridge East

Island North of the Malahat

Hope springs eternal in the heart of centre right campaign managers that this time will be the time for a breakthrough on the Island. Some of these seats have voted federal Reform or Conservative and could be open to a populist appeal.

- Courtenay-Comox
- Ladysmith-Oceanside

Potential Green Seats

As all third parties, the Greens suffer in a FPTP system. That said, they have high hopes to three seats

- Saanich North and the Islands
- Victoria-Beacon Hill
